The campaign was carried on in cooperation with the Child Conservation Section of the Field Division of the Council of National Defense as a distinct war measure. European experience showed that war-time conditions affect children adversely, even disastrously, and that the protection of its children is a primary essential to a nation at war. It also demonstrated that even under these conditions determined effort can accomplish much toward shielding children from the effects of war. The Children s Bureau, therefore, felt that it could offer no more valuable contribution to the country during the war than to assist in stimulating and coordinating public and volunteer effort for child welfare and to put its experience at the service of the Council of National Defense and other agencies undertaking work in behalf of children.
